SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Chief Judge Marlin J. Appelwick, Washington Court of Appeals Div. I - Judge Marlin Appelwick joined the Court of Appeals in 1998. He came to the court from 18 years of private practice in a small Lake City law firm, where he focused on family law, business law, and mediation. He combined his years of practice with 16 years as a member of the Washington State Legislature. His service as a state representative included 12 years on the budget committee and 12 years on the Judiciary Committee, six as chair. In his final three years, he served as the House Democratic Leader. Governor Locke appointed him to the court, and he has three times been elected to the position.

Judge Appelwick's service and achievements have been acknowledged by awards that include: President's Award from the Washington State Bar Association (2011); Judicial Leadership Award Access to Justice Board of the Washington State Bar Association (2008); Judge William Nevin Award from the Washington Judges' Foundation (2006); Distinguished Alumni Achievement Award from Minnesota State University (2002); Honorary Order of the Coif from the University of Washington Law School (1997); Commendation Award from the National Commission Against Drunk Driving (1994); Lifetime Achievement Award from the Washington State Trial Lawyers Association (1994); Professional of the Year Award from the Family Law Section of the Washington State Bar Association (1993); the President's

Award from the Washington State Bar Association for his work securing funding for legal services to the poor (1992); and the President's Award of Merit from the Washington State District and Municipal Court Judges Association (1991).

Richard Johnson, Washington Court of Appeals Div. I - Richard D. Johnson is the Court Administrator/Clerk of Division I, Court of Appeals. Prior to joining the Washington State Court of Appeals in 1998, Mr. Johnson was the Deputy Court Administrator of Branch Operations and Information Systems for the Los Angeles Municipal Court. Mr. Johnson has a Master's Degree in Public Administration and Certification in Judicial Administration from the University of Southern California. He is also a Fellow of the Institute for Court Management.
