SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Michael G. Malaier, Office of the Chapter 13 Trustee – Michael G. Malaier is the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee for the Western District of Washington-Tacoma/Vancouver. He oversees 17 employees, conducts 341 meetings, reviews cases prior to and following confirmation, drafts motions and memoranda concerning all issues relevant to Chapter 13, and appears in court regularly. A native of Federal Way, Washington, he is a graduate, *magna cum laude*, of Santa Clara University and received his J.D. from the University of Arizona in 2003. Prior to entering the field of bankruptcy law as Staff Attorney to his predecessor, David M. Howe, Mike enjoyed a criminal defense practice representing both privately-retained and publicly-assigned clients. He has a keen interest in maintaining Chapter 13 as a viable and robust program for assisting Debtors in getting back on their feet.
