SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Andrew Siegel, Seattle University School of Law – Andrew Siegel is an Associate Professor at Seattle University School of Law where he was until recently the Associate Dean for Planning and Strategic Initiatives. Professor Siegel is a nationally recognized expert on constitutional law and the United States Supreme Court, whose writings on the subject frequently appear in major law journals and in popular outlets such as The Washington Post and The New Republic. Before entering teaching, he received a BA in history summa cum laude from Yale University, an MA in history from Princeton University, and his JD summa cum laude from New York University School of Law, clerked for Judge Pierre Leval and Justice John Paul Stevens, and worked at the law firm now known as WilmerHale. He lives in Seattle with his wife—also a Law Professor—and their six children.
