SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Laura Edmonston, Washington State Law Library - Laura Edmonston has served as the state’s Deputy Law Librarian and manager for the reference staff since 2015. She developed her legal research skills as a librarian for the Louisiana House of Representatives. Laura has a bachelor’s degree from the University of Oregon, a master’s degree in Library and Information Science from Louisiana State University, and a Certificate of Paralegal Studies from Duke. In addition to her role at the State Law Library, she also serves as the embedded librarian for the courts’ Gender and Justice Commission.
