SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Bruce Moen, Moen Law Offices, P.S. – Bruce Moen has been in private practice in the State of Washington since 1976. For the past 25 years, his practice has been limited to estate administrations and litigation. This involves both representing private parties and accepting Court appointments as a fiduciary in contested estates. Mr. Moen has been appointed by the Court as a Personal Representative, Special Administrator, Special Master, Guardian, or Trustee in contested estates over 100 times and as Guardian ad Litem approximately 200 times over the past 25 years. He is regularly consulted or retained as an expert by other attorneys engaged in defending and prosecuting estate matters or in resolving difficult issues of estate administration. He has periodically served as a Judge pro tem in the King County Superior Court and served regularly as a Court Commissioner pro tem from 1990 to 2010.
