SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Laura Anglin, Washington Supreme Court - Laura Anglin graduated from Seattle University summa cum laude in 1999. She has spent most of the time since clerking for Justices Charles Johnson, Phil Talmadge, Tom Chambers, and Steve González at the Washington State Supreme Court. In 2014 she received the Professionalism Award from the Washington State Bar Association in recognition of her many hours mentoring law students, law clerks, and externs. The award is both heavy and pointy. She left the court briefly to work for the Washington State Senate as Senate Counsel where she sat at Lieutenant Governor Cyrus Habib’s left hand in an impressive but uncomfortable chair on the rostrum of the State Senate and advised senators on parliamentary, legal, and ethical issues. After a brief stint as a tax referee at the Board of Tax Appeals, she has returned to clerk for Justice González almost as if nothing happened.
