**SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY**

**Deborah Crawley, Brain Injury Alliance of Washington** - Deborah has a 25 year career in non-profit management, program development and evaluation. She began at Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center on the longest longitudinal youth smoking prevention study in the U.S. She then spent 17 years working with the leading national developer of prevention education for K-12 youth, including development and evaluation of the first CDC “Program that Works” in HIV/AIDS Education/Prevention for school-age youth and “proven effective” programs in drug/alcohol/violence and tobacco prevention.

Her breadth of experience also includes 4 years serving the working poor of Seattle as the Director of Communications & Development for the Millionair Club Charity just prior to joining the Brain Injury Alliance of Washington in January, 2010.

In 2018 she led the organization in the development of the Pooled Alliance Community Trusts|PACT. Bringing together a team of leaders in the Trust Community this unique offering has expanded BIAWA’s role within the larger disabled and special needs community.
