SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Debbie Gallagher, Supervised Visitation Facilitator – Before opening her private practice of supervised visitation in 2016, Debbie was a State of Washington social worker for 27 years, primarily within the Division of Children and Family Services.

During this time, she provided therapy to CPS clients needing in-home reunification and family reconciliation services. She has also been a contract therapist for a specialized project with incarcerated women helping them reunite with their children and integrating them back into the community.

She has been paid and volunteer Guardian Ad Litem in Family and Dependency court and was a visitation supervisor with The Indaba Center under the leadership of Karin Ballantyne.

Currently, Debbie volunteers with The Unified Family court training committee, is an active member of AFCC (Association of Family and Conciliation Courts) and provides supervised visitation services to the general community.

Angel Katchka, A Kat's Eye Supervised Visitation – Angel Katchka, owner of A Kat's Eye Supervised Visitation, has been serving children in King, Skagit, and Snohomish County for 18 years. She continues to provide services during the Covid Pandemic.

A member in good standing with the Supervised Visitation Network (SVN), a worldwide organization. Katchka served as co-chair of the Washington Chapter of SVN for over five years, helping to develop resource materials and promoting professional supervised visitation in Washington State.

Anastacia Fedina, Helping Hands Visitations Services – Prior to opening Helping Hands Visitation Services in 2013, Anastacia Fedina worked with the Division of Child and Family Services, providing supervised visitation for foster children and their parents.

Currently, she serves as a Guardian ad Litem for Kitsap County Superior Court and is Vice President of Runway to Freedom, a nonprofit organization that provides resources and support to victims of domestic violence while continuing to provide supervised visitation services to King, Pierce and Snohomish counties.

Toshua Henry, AtIndaba – Toshua brings over a decade of Supervised Visitation experience including six years working at Indaba Center prior to graduating from the University of Washington Graduate School of Social Work at which point Toshua purchased Indaba Center and launched AtIndaba Supervised Visitation and in less than six short years has grown At Indaba into the largest private supervised visitation agency in the Pacific Northwest with two Seattle offices and two more slated to come online later this year to more effectively serve clients across Puget Sound.
