SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Kevin Hanchett, Resource Transition Consultants LLC - Kevin became licensed to practice law in the state of Washington in 1986. He was with the Lasher Holzapfel Sperry & Ebberson PLLC for over 31 years, originally as an associate attorney, then a principal for 13 years and then in an of counsel role until 2019. Initially, his practice focused on debtor/creditor issues and bankruptcy. He has been involved in approximately 2,000 bankruptcy cases and served on the committee that proposed the revised receivership statute which was signed into law in 2004.

In 2008, Kevin formed Resource Transition Consultants, LLC (“RTC”). RTC acts as a court appointed receiver to analyze troubled businesses and assets and evaluate the best technique to maximize the value of the assets for the benefit of creditors. The primary focus of RTC in its role as a court appointed receiver is to gain control and stabilize the assets, add value and liquidate the assets and or restructure the business in receivership. RTC has been appointed as a receiver in approximately 200 matters in Washington, Oregon, Alaska, Idaho, Nevada, Arizona, Texas and North Carolina.
