### SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

**Carla Calogero, Reed Longyear Malnati & Ahrens PLLC** – Carla Calogero is a Member Attorney at Reed Longyear Malnati & Ahrens PLLC. Carla’s practice is limited to the representation of lay and professional fiduciaries, persons involved in guardianships, probates, trusts, and vulnerable adult protective actions, probates, and to advance care and estate planning.

She is regularly appointed by the King County Superior Court to serve as Guardian ad Litem, attorney, or Special Representative for alleged incapacitated persons, adjudicated incapacitated persons and minors in guardianship, trust, probate and civil litigation matters.
