SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY:

Hon. Henry Judson, III, King County Superior Court – Commissioner Judson was appointed as a Constitutional Commissioner to the King County Superior Court in July 2014. He currently serves in the Ex Parte/Probate Department in the King County Courthouse in Seattle. Prior to his appointment he focused his practice in the areas of Guardianship, Probate, Trusts and Elder Law. He was a certified professional Guardian, and served as a Guardian of the Person and/or Estate of Incapacitated Persons, a Guardian ad Litem, Trustee and Personal Representative of Decedent’s estates upon court appointment. From 2007 through 2009 he served as a Co-Chair of the King County Bar Association’s Title 11 Guardianship GAL Program. Commissioner Judson received his B.A. from Pomona College in 1977 and his J.D. from the Northwestern School of Law of Lewis and Clark College in 1980.
