SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY:

Robert Cumbow, Miller Nash Graham & Dunn - Bob Cumbow, partner at the Seattle office of Miller Nash Graham & Dunn, will present a general background on the Right of Publicity with a focus on how recent cases in this area of law suggest an uneasy future for First Amendment jurisprudence.
